Applications are invited from eligible candidates for engagement as **Guest Faculty and Life Guard** in the National Sports University, Imphal, for filling up **10 (Ten) positions** purely on a temporary basis for a period of **six (6) months initially**, which may be extended further, depending upon the requirement and need of the University, as detailed below.

For Guest Faculty: The engagement shall be strictly on a **per lecture/period basis**. The honorarium shall be **₹1,500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred only) per lecture/period**, subject to a maximum of **₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) per month**, as per UGC guidelines.

For Life Guard: The honorarium shall be **₹30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) per month**.

A Master's degree with 55% marks for UR and 50% marks for SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy Layer) candidates (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Exercise Physiology/Sports Physiology/Human Physiology/Sports Science (Exercise Physiology specialization) from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited Foreign University. II. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or CSIR, or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may be, are exempted from NET. However, in subject areas where UGC-NET is not available, an exemption may be considered as per UGC Norms. Desirable I. One year of teaching or research experience or experience of direct physiological monitoring of sports persons.
10.	Guest Faculty- (Sports Psychology) - 01	I. Master's Degree in Sports Psychology/ Psychology or an equivalent degree from an Indian or accredited foreign university with at least 55% marks for UR and 50% marks for SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy Layer) candidates. II. National Eligibility Test (NET) in Psychology. However, Sports Psychology Master's degree candidates are exempted from NET as there is no NET in Sports Psychology. III. Candidates who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the provisions contained in the Para 4.1 (I)(A)(II), UGC Regulations 2018 are exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET. Desirable One year experience of working with sportspersons.
