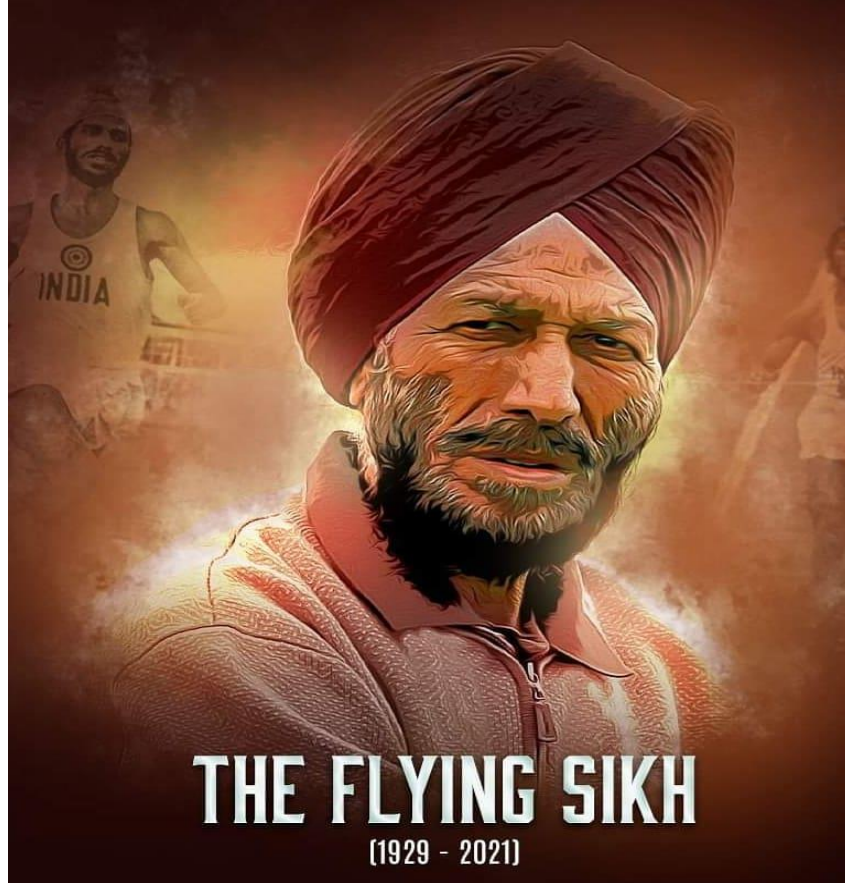

National Sports University mourns the loss of Milkha Singh, India's most celebrated athlete, best known as the Flying Sikh.



Milkha Singh succumbed to COVID-19 complications on June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021, but he will be remembered and he will always be alive in the memories of all.

The legend of Milkha Singh will be celebrated for generations. The Padma Shri awardee, Milkha Singh had multiple feathers on his cap. He won four Asian gold medals and finished fourth in the 400m final at the 1960 Rome Olympics. He won five golds in International Athletic Championships and was awarded the Helms World Trophy in 1959 for winning 77 of his 80 international races. He also won India's first Commonwealth Gold in 1958.

He inspired many young athletes to take on the track. His humble yet steadfast nature made him India's pride. His name is one that will always be cherished. His spirits will continue to fly like him.
