Release of Admit Cards for National Sports University Entrance Examination (NSUEE) -2021

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will be conducting the Entrance Examination of the National Sports University (NSUEE) -2021, for admission to various courses on **10th September 2021 (Friday)**, following 'Online Based Test-Remote Proctored' mode (**OBT-RP**).

Admit cards of candidates for appearing in the exam, will be hosted on <https://nsu.nta.ac.in/>

Candidates are required to download their Admit Card, from the said website, using their Application Number and Date of Birth and should carefully read the instructions contained therein.

Candidates are advised to note the following:

- The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility conditions.
- Admit Card will not be sent by post.
- Candidate must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility, which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of the admission process.
- Candidates are advised to preserve a copy of their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
