About The Quiz

- 3. All the participants must submit the quiz form before it expires at 10:15 am.
- 4. Participants will be required to provide their name, email address and phone number in the google form.
- 5. Participants can attempt the quiz only once. Multiple entries from the same participants will not be entertained.
- 6. There will be fifty (50) Multiple Choice questions.
- 7. There will be no negative marking for wrong answers.
- 8. Participants can view their score right after the completion of the quiz through registered email ID.
- 9. The participants shall abide by all the terms and conditions of the quiz competition, including any amendments.
- 10. Organizers will not be held responsible for those entries that are lost, late submission, incomplete or have not been submitted due to computer error or any others technical problems.
- 11. In case of tie in the preliminary round the minimum time taken to complete the question by the candidate will be considered.
- 12. Organizer's decision on the quiz shall be final and no correspondence will be entertained regarding the same.

	• On the immediate completion of a question, each participantwill get 5 secondsto
	answer the question.
	• 10 points will be awarded for the right answer.
	There will be no Negative points for the wrong answer.
	Questions will not be passed to the next participant.
Audio-visual round	• Each participant will be shown a picture and the participant has toidentify the picture
	in 10 seconds.
	In this round 2pictureswill be shown toeach participant.
	No negative points for wrong answers
	Questions will not be passed to the next participant.
Tie Breaker Round (In case of a tie)	• In case of a tie after the 3rd round, the tied participants will get into a Tie
	Breaker Round.
	• 5 questions will be asked in this round.
	• The participant who types the word "NSU" correctly and send to the chat box
	first will be given the chance to answer the question.
	 If a participant doesn't answer or gives a wrong answer will lose 5 points. If any participant types the word "NSU" in the chat box before the question is
	complete the participants will beasked to answer only after the completion of
	the question.
	 The question has to be answered in 10 seconds.
	 If anyparticipant givesright answer they get 10 points. If wrong answer, they
	getminus 5 points.
