**Sub: Reopening of physical classes.**

Dear students,

1. As per UGC letter no. 14-8/2020(CPP-II) dated 05-11-2020 and guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India and State Govt., National Sports University has decided to open the university campus in a phased manner from 01<sup>st</sup> February, 2021 on wards. The first and second phases are already reported and the physical classes were going on. Now, the university has decided to call the third and fourth phases from the senior semester students i.e.

3. In this regard, students from III phases are advised to report at the campus between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 for joining the physical classes. Students from IV phases are advised to report for physical classes between 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2021.
4. Before starting from your home for the campus, you are advised to get yourself tested for COVID-19 (RT-PCR test) as close to the date of arrival at the university as possible but not earlier than 72 hours before the date of your arrival at the campus and the test report has to send through WhatsApp to the following HOD's, i) Dr. Lamlun Buhril, Physical Education (9565276295) ii) Dr. Shyam Sundar Rath, Sports Coaching (7008564825) and iii) Prof. R. Subramanian, Sports Psychology, (9444946213) well in advance. If the report is found positive, you are advised not to proceed for the campus but to stay at home and take all the precautions as advised by the doctor and keep us updated with your health status regularly.
5. After receiving the negative report of RT-PCR test for COVID-19, you are advised to inform your hostel warden of your date of arrival and mode of transportation. You are required to submit the RT-PCR negative report while reporting at the campus along with Undertakings from the self and the parents/guardian as per the format attached, failing which you will not allowed to enter the campus.

6. You will be provided single room accommodation in the hostel and will be required to go mandatory home quarantine for seven days in your hostel room. Packed food will be provided to you during the mandatory quarantine.
7. On 6<sup>th</sup> day of mandatory quarantine, you will be tested for COVID-19. After receiving negative report, you will be allowed to attend the physical classes. If the COVID-19 test report is found positive, you will be further quarantined for another period of 7 days. Symptomatic cases, if any, will be taken to the COVID care facilities in coordination with the Department of Health, Govt. of Manipur for treatment.
8. The university has made extensive arrangements for the students at the campus to help them stay safe and physically and mentally healthy. Detailed Plans and Guidelines have been worked out for the purpose .
9. We want to assure you as well as parents and guardians that we have taken appropriate steps to keep you safe during your stay at the campus. However, for these measure to succeed the students, apart from faculty and staff, have to commit themselves to fulfill their obligation and adhere to the SOPs and guidelines issued by the university strictly. Self-discipline is the key to stop the spread of COVID-19. We request all the parents/guardians to make their wards aware of the SOPs issued by the university, Ministry of Health and Welfare, Govt. of India and State Government. We require full cooperation of the students for making the teaching-learning process smooth and as safe as it could be. For more details please refer to the SOPs issued by the university.
10. Despite these measures if you still decide not to come to the campus, you have the option to do so and in such case we will continue to provide you the teaching and learning material online as is being done so far.
11. You are requested to study the attached documents carefully and inform about your state of arrival to the campus to Dr. A. Yuvaraj (Boys hostel) (Mobile no. 9444497050) / Mr. Anshuman Bal (Boys Hostel ) ( Mobile no. 8249587714) and Ms. Manjinder Jyoti (Girls Hostel) (Mobile no. 7355541634).
